To Our School Community,

The MSAD 6 School Board is in the process of developing a revised District Strategic Plan that will provide direction for decisions about the facilities, staffing, programming, and systems moving forward. The Strategic Plan is an important document that provides clarity and purpose to the District's Mission and Vision statements. The Board has established an Ad Hoc Committee to complete this work with stakeholders and ensure that the revised Strategic Plan reflects the expectations of the MSAD 6 community. The Committee is planning to present to the full Board with a revised Strategic Plan in May 2020.

The Committee will use two different methods to solicit feedback from stakeholders: Community Forums and ThoughtExchange, an electronic sharing of thoughts. ThoughtExchange is an electronic method of creating a modern community discussion. Stakeholders may access the link by visiting the [bonnyeagle.org](https://www.bonnyeagle.org) web page. The community discussion is designed around a single focus question, and stakeholders have the opportunity to respond as well as comment on all ideas or thoughts. As the community dialogue expands, a trend develops that will provide the feedback necessary for the Committee to better understand stakeholder expectations. I've attached the scheduled opportunities for community members to attend forums in each town. By providing stakeholders two different methods of engagement, the Committee is hopeful that many community members will participate and establish stakeholder expectations for educating our children.

Our children are our most valuable community resource and worthy of our commitment and investment. The global economy is not only competitive--it's continuously changing. To fulfill the MSAD 6 Mission, "Helping All Students Reach Their Full Potential", we must also evolve to ensure that ALL of our students have opportunities and pathways to reach their potential.
